

ARTIST STATEMENT

My practice explores memory, belonging, and the quiet emotional weight carried by everyday objects. I work across painting, surface design, illustration, animation, and children's storytelling, using colour and playful imagery to reflect on childhood, family, and cultural memory. Objects often become stand-ins for lived experiences, holding stories of care, comfort, and connection.

After losing my mother to cancer and becoming a parent myself, I began creating art while processing grief while also honoring joy- art that offered a sense of repose and emotional growth. I am interested in how art can hold tenderness, protection that many of us felt as kids, especially how familiar imagery can create space for reflection and belonging.

Food, domestic objects, and moments drawn from travel and childhood stories frequently appear in my work. These elements allow me to explore how memory is carried through the senses while becoming a deep shared experience. I am especially drawn to the ways in which cultural traditions and everyday practices shape identity across generations.

Through my work, I aim to create visual narratives that feel nourishing and accessible. Whether through a painted object, a children's book, or a playful interactive project, I hope to invite viewers into moments of recognition, comfort, and joy.
